### Daytona Notes of Interest:

- **Dynamic Duo:** While this is Harvick’s 20<sup>th</sup> year in the NASCAR Cup Series, it’s his seventh with crew chief Rodney Childers, which is the longest pairing of any current driver-crew chief combination. Since joining forces at Stewart-Haas Racing (SHR) in 2014, Harvick and Childers have combined to produce 26 points-paying victories, a victory in the non-points-paying 2018 Monster Energy NASCAR All-Star Race at Charlotte (N.C.) Motor Speedway, 25 poles, 106 top-five finishes and 153 top-10s while leading 9,611 laps. They won the 2014 championship, finished runner-up in the 2015 title chase to champion Kyle Busch, finished eighth in 2016 and third in 2017, 2018 and 2019.
- Harvick has career totals of **49 wins, 31 poles, 206 top-fives, 362 top-10s and 14,043 laps led in 682 starts.**
  - His **most recent Cup Series win and Busch Pole** both came in November 2019 at Texas Motor Speedway in Fort Worth.
- **Harvick’s 49 career NASCAR Cup Series victories puts him in a tie with his boss, Tony Stewart, for 14<sup>th</sup> on the all-time NASCAR Cup Series wins list.** He is third on the active driver list behind Jimmie Johnson and Busch. Harvick’s next win will tie him with Junior Johnson and Ned Jarrett for 13<sup>th</sup> on the all-time list with 50 wins.
- **At Homestead in 2019, Harvick became just the 11<sup>th</sup> driver to have led 14,000 laps in his NASCAR career.** He’s led 14,034 and trails 10<sup>th</sup>-place Busch, who has led 17,423, and Johnson, who is ninth with 18,834 laps led.
- **Harvick in the NASCAR Cup Series at Daytona:** Harvick has two wins, nine top-five finishes, 14 top-10s and has led a total of 256 laps in his 36 career points-paying NASCAR Cup Series starts at Daytona. His average start is 14.8, his average finish is 17.8 and he has a lap-completion rate of 88.7 percent, completing 5,762 of the 6,495 laps available.

**Daytona 500 Notes of Interest (continued):**

- **2007 Daytona 500 Champion:** Harvick won the 2007 Daytona 500 when he beat NASCAR Hall of Famer Mark Martin to the finish line by .02 of a second on the final green-white-checked restart. It stands as the second-closest finish in Daytona 500 history, trailing only Denny Hamlin’s .01-of-a-second advantage over Martin Truex Jr., in 2016.
- **Wins at Daytona:** In addition to his three wins in the non-points Clash at Daytona (2009, 2010, 2013), Harvick has five other victories at the famed 2.5-mile racetrack – the two NASCAR Cup Series points-paying events (February 2007, July 2010), two other non-points events (2013 and 2019 Gander RV Duel) and a win in the NASCAR Xfinity Series (February 2007).
- **Harvick in the Xfinity Series at Daytona:** Harvick has 19 career starts in the Xfinity Series at Daytona. He has the February 2007 win, three poles, 12 top-five finishes and 14 top-10s. He has led 230 laps, has an average starting position of 8.8 and average finish of 7.6, and has completed 99.2 percent (2,102 of 2,119) of the laps he’s contested there.
- **Harvick in the Rolex 24 at Daytona:** Harvick drove the No. 90 Flis Motorsports entry in the American GT class of the 2002 Rolex 24 at Daytona. The four-driver team consisted of Harvick, Dave Liniger, Rick Carelli and John Metcalf. The team finished eighth in class after a mechanical issue forced the car’s retirement after completing 123 of 716 laps.
- **Harvick in the IROC Series at Daytona:** Harvick, the 2002 IROC champion, made three starts at Daytona in the series with a best finish of seventh in 2003 and 2004.
- **110 and Counting** – Harvick scored his 100<sup>th</sup> career win in NASCAR’s top three series when he won the Cup Series race at Las Vegas Motor Speedway in March 2018. He now has 110 total victories – 49 in the Cup Series, 47 in the Xfinity Series and 14 in the Truck Series. Only three other drivers in NASCAR history have passed 100 wins in NASCAR’s top three series: Richard Petty, David Pearson and Busch.
