- The Haas Automation driver has **six NASCAR Xfinity Series starts at the mile oval in Arizona**. He started and finished second in last year's November race. **He also has three NASCAR Truck Series starts** at Phoenix with a highest finishing position of third in November 2014. Custer also has three starts and **one win in the NASCAR K&N Pro Series West** division at Phoenix.
- 2020 mark's Custer's first full-time season in the Cup Series and he is contending for Rookie of the Year honors along with four other Cup Series competitors.
- Ford has 16 Cup Series wins at Phoenix Raceway.
