Darlington II Raceway Notes of Interest:

- Cole Custer will make his second Darlington (S.C.) Raceway NASCAR Cup Series start Wednesday, bringing his total career Cup Series starts to nine.
- The 22-year-old finished 22nd at Darlington Raceway behind the wheel of the HaasTooling.com Mustang.
- The HaasTooling.com driver has **three NASCAR Xfinity Series starts** at the 1.366-mile track in South Carolina. His lone victory at Darlington came last year after the original winner was disqualified. In 2018, Custer finished the race second in only his second Xfinity Series start. In all three career Xfinity Series outings, he has started and finished inside the top-10.
- 2020 mark's Custer's first full-time season in the Cup Series, and he is contending for Rookie of the Year honors along with four other Cup Series competitors.
