Busch Pole Qualifying for the Coca-Cola 600

Event: Busch Pole qualifying for the Coca-Cola 600
Series: NASCAR Cup Series
Location: Charlotte (N.C.) Motor Speedway (1.5-mile oval)
Pole Winner: Kurt Busch of Chip Ganassi Racing (29.790 seconds at 181.269 mph)

SHR Results:

- Clint Bowyer (20th, 30.095 seconds at 179.432 mph)
- Kevin Harvick (22nd, 30.156 seconds at 179.069 mph)
- Cole Custer (28th, 30.334 seconds at 178.018 mph)
- Aric Almirola (40th, no time)

Format:

- One-lap, single-car qualifying run for all drivers. (Sets positions 1-40.)

Notes:

- This is Bowyer's 17th top-20 starting spot at Charlotte's oval in 27 career attempts.
- This marks just the second time since joining SHR in 2014 that Harvick has qualified outside the top-11 at Charlotte's oval.
- This was Custer's first NASCAR Cup Series qualifying effort on Charlotte's oval.
- Almirola spun off turn four before taking the green flag for his qualifying lap. He did not set a time.
- Kurt Busch won his 28th career Busch Pole, his first at Charlotte's oval and his first of the season. He beat next best Jimmie Johnson by .009 of a second.
- The Coca-Cola 600 starts at 6 p.m. EDT tonight with live coverage provided by FOX and SiriusXM NASCAR Radio.
