Atlanta Notes of Interest:

- Cole Custer will make his 13th career Cup Series start Sunday and his first at Atlanta Motor Speedway.
- Custer's day ended prematurely last Sunday at Bristol (Tenn.) Motor Speedway after he was collected in a multicar accident.
- The California native earned 12th- and 18th-place finishes at the series' most recent events at a 1.5-mile track Charlotte (N.C.) Motor Speedway May 24 and May 27, respectively.
- The 22-year-old driver has **three NASCAR Xfinity Series starts** at Atlanta, most recently qualifying on the pole and finishing second last year. Custer also has **one NASCAR Gander RV & Outdoors Truck Series start** at Atlanta, which resulted in a 17th-place finish.
- 2020 mark's Custer's first full-time season in the Cup Series, and he is contending for Rookie of the Year honors along with four other competitors.
