- Cole Custer will make his 15th career Cup Series start Sunday at Homestead-Miami Speedway, and his first at the 1.5-mile South Florida oval.
- Custer has four NASCAR Xfinity Series starts at Homestead, with one win and one pole award. He hasn't started or finished outside of the top-two spot's in his last three Xfinity Series starts there.
- The California native also has one **NASCAR Gander RV & Outdoors Truck Series start** at Homestead. He earned a 10th-place finish in November 2016.
- The HaasTooling.com driver earned a 29th-place result Wednesday night at Martinsville (Va.) Speedway with a tight-handling Ford Mustang.
- 2020 mark's Custer's first full-time season in the Cup Series, and he is contending for Rookie of the Year honors along with four other competitors.
