Talladega Superpeedway Notes of Interest:

- Cole Custer will make his 16th career Cup Series start Sunday afternoon at Talladega (Ala.) Superspeedway, and his first at the 2.66-mile oval.
- Custer has three NASCAR Xfinity Series starts at the Alabama track with a best finish of ninth.
- The 22-year-old also has one NASCAR Gander RV & Outdoors Truck Series start at Talladega. He earned the pole position in October of 2016 but his race ended early after being caught up in an accident.
- The HaasTooling.com driver earned a 22nd-place finish last Sunday at Homestead-Miami Speedway with a tight-handling Ford Mustang.
- 2020 marks Custer's first full-time season in the Cup Series, and he is contending for Rookie of the Year honors along with four other competitors.
