Atlanta Notes of Interest:

- Almirola will make his 10th NASCAR Cup Series start at Atlanta this weekend to bring his total of career **Cup Series starts to 326**.
 - The Smithfield driver is looking to capture his third top-10 finish of the season.
 - O Almirola has earned two top-10s Atlanta, including last year's eighth-place finish from the pole.
- In addition to his nine Cup Series starts at Atlanta, Almirola has three NASCAR Xfinity Series starts and four NASCAR Gander RV & Outdoors Truck Series starts.
 - O Almirola's Xfinity Series statistics at Atlanta feature one top-10 with 99.5 percent of all possible laps completed. The Tampa, Florida native has two top-five finishes and two top-10s there in the Truck Series.
 - Atlanta is the fourth intermediate race of the 2020 season for Almirola and the No. 10 Smithfield Ford Mustang team.
- Career: Almirola has career totals of two wins, two poles, 18 top-five finishes, 64 top-10s and 543 laps led in 324 starts.
- **Points:** Almirola sits 11th in the driver standings with 240 points 130 behind leader and SHR teammate Kevin Harvick.
- Last win: Almirola's Oct. 14, 2018 win at Talladega (Ala.) Superspeedway was his most recent in the Cup Series.
