Pocono Notes of Interest:

- Almirola will make his 16th start in the NASCAR Cup Series at Pocono (Pa.) Raceway this weekend to bring his total of career **Cup Series starts to 329**.
 - Almirola has one start at the "Tricky Triangle" in the NASCAR Xfinity Series in June 2016, which resulted in an 11th-place finish. He's also made one start in the NASCAR Gander RV & Outdoors Truck Series in July 2010 and earned a fourth-place finish.
 - Almirola has two top-10 finishes at Pocono since joining Stewart-Haas Racing. His best finish at the 2.5-mile track is seventh, earned June 3, 2018.
- Almirola will race for his third consecutive top-five finish this weekend. He has earned five top-10s this season.
- Career: Almirola has career totals of two wins, two poles, 20 top-five finishes, 66 top-10s and 543 laps led in 329 starts.
- **Points:** Almirola sits 13th in the driver standings with 336 points 153 behind leader and SHR teammate Kevin Harvick.
- Last win: Almirola's Oct. 14, 2018 win at Talladega (Ala.) Superspeedway was his most recent in the Cup Series.
