Kansas Speedway Notes of Interest:

- Cole Custer will make his 22nd career Cup Series start Thursday night at Kansas Speedway in Kansas City. It will be the rookie's first Cup Series start on the 1.5-mile oval.
- Custer has four NASCAR Xfinity Series starts at the Midwest track with a best finish of 11th earned in last year's race. The California native also has one Kansas appearance in the NASCAR Gander RV & Outdoor Series where he finished seventh after starting fourth.
- The HaasTooling.com driver earned his first Cup Series win in just his 20th start two weekends ago at Kentucky Speedway in Sparta.
- The California native's win put him in a category with 33 other drivers who have won in each of NASCAR's three national series.
- 2020 mark's Custer's first full-time season in the Cup Series, and he is contending for Rookie of the Year honors along with four other competitors. Custer's Kentucky win made him the first rookie driver to win this season.
