Bristol NASCAR All-Star Notes of Interest:

- Almirola has two NASCAR All-Star Race appearances. He finished 14th in 2015 and sixth last year.
- Almirola earned his sixth consecutive top-10 Sunday at Kentucky Speedway in Sparta. He finished fifth June 14 at Homestead-Miami Speedway, third June 22 at Talladega (Ala.) Superspeedway, third and fifth in the June 27 and 28 doubleheader at Pocono (Pa.) Raceway, and third July 5 in the Brickyard 400 at Indianapolis Motor Speedway. Almirola's next-best streak of races in his career was a run of six consecutive top-10s in 2019 that began with the second race at Atlanta Motor Speedway and lasted through the season's seventh race at Texas Motor Speedway in Fort Worth.

- Career: Almirola has career totals of two wins, two poles, 23 top-five finishes, 70 top-10s and 755 laps led in 333 starts.

- Last win: Almirola's Oct. 14, 2018 win at Talladega (Ala.) Superspeedway was his most recent in the Cup Series.
