- Almirola has two top-10 road-course finishes – both earned at Sonoma (Calif.) Raceway with Stewart-Haas Racing.
- Almirola will race for his 11<sup>th</sup> top-10 finish in 12 races.
- Almirola has earned 10 top-10 finishes in the last 11 races with five of those being top-fives. His average finish is 6.5 over the last 11 races.
- **Career:** Almirola has career totals of two wins, two poles, 23 top-five finishes, 74 top-10s and 801 laps led in 338 starts.
- **Points:** Almirola sits eighth in the driver standings with 669 points – 247 behind leader and SHR teammate Kevin Harvick.
- **Last win:** Almirola’s Oct. 14, 2018 win at Talladega was his most recent in the Cup Series.
