Notes of Interest:

- Bowyer owns career totals of **10 wins, three poles, 82 top-five finishes, 224 top-10s and 3,170 laps led in 536 NASCAR Cup Series races.** He also owns eight NASCAR Xfinity Series victories.
- His **most recent Cup Series victory** came at Michigan International Speedway in Brooklyn (June 10, 2018).
- His **most recent Cup Series pole** came at Auto Club Speedway in Fontana, California on Feb. 29, 2020.
- **Last weekend at Talladega:** Bowyer started ninth and, after dodging an early accident, looked to be in good position to collect bonus points in the second stage. But Bowyer and Jimmie Johnson made contact in the tri-oval on lap 108, triggering a multicar accident that ended Bowyer's race and left him with a 33rd-place finish.
- **2020 Playoffs:** Bowyer earned top-10 finishes in each of the Round of 16 playoff races – 10th at Darlington (S.C.) Raceway and Richmond (Va.) Raceway, and sixth at Bristol (Tenn.) Motor Speedway. He finished 12th at Las Vegas Motor Speedway and 33rd at Talladega on Sunday in the first two Round of 12 playoff races.
- This is Bowyer's ninth playoff appearance and his third in a row. He **finished a career-best second in the 2012 NASCAR Cup Series playoffs.**
- Bowyer has posted **four NASCAR Cup Series playoff victories** – New Hampshire Motor Speedway in Loudon in 2007 and 2010, Talladega in 2010 and Charlotte (N.C.) Motor Speedway in 2012.
- **SHR has one pole, four top-five and five top-10 finishes in eight starts on the Charlotte roval. On the oval, SHR owns five poles and one points-paying win** (Kevin Harvick in October 2014), plus eight top-five finishes and 24 top-10s in 70 starts.
- **Bowyer on Charlotte Roval 2019:** Bowyer entered the Round of 16's final race 14th in points, just four markers outside the top-12 cutoff. He finished third in the first two stages and fourth in the race to advance to the Round of 12.
- **Bowyer on Charlotte Roval 2018:** Bowyer entered the Round of 16's final race 13th in points, just four markers outside the top-12 cutoff. A third-place finish was enough to propel Bowyer to the Round of 12.
- **All-time wins list: With 10 career victories,** Bowyer is in a 59th-place tie on the all-time Cup Series wins list with Donnie Allison and Sterling Marlin.
