Notes of Interest:

- Almirola finished third in his most recent start at Talladega on June 22. That result tied the record of eight consecutive Talladega top-10s set by Dale Earnhardt Jr., between April 2001 and October 2004.
- Almirola's average finish in the last eight races at Talladega is 5.1 the best average finish in the series.
- Almirola has nine career top-10 finishes at Talladega eight consecutively. He also owns five top-five finishes at the 2.66-mile superspeedway.
- In the NASCAR Xfinity Series at Talladega, Almirola visited Talladega's victory lane in May 2017.
- 2020 Season: The No. 10 Ford driver has a career-high six top-five finishes and a career-high-tying 17 top-10s with 288 laps led.
- Career: Almirola has career totals of two wins, two poles, 24 top-five finishes, 78 top-10s and 825 laps led in 346 starts in the Cup Series
- **Playoff Standings:** Almirola sits 11th in the playoff standings with 3,025 points 27 points below top-eight cutoff to advance to the next round.
- Last win: Almirola's Oct. 14, 2018 win at Talladega was his most recent in the NASCAR Cup Series.
